

Kanya Mahavidyalaya, a higher education institution for girls, situated at Geetanagar, Guwahati-781021(Assam) has been imparting education upto graduate level since 16th September, 1977. The college has been established by the effort of a group of educationists and social workers of Pub-Guwahati area which started its academic activities at Pub-Guwahati Girls' High School and administrative activities at the residence of Suchibrata Raichoudhury, recipient of Sahitya Academy Award. Khanindra Chandra Barua and Suchibrata Raichoudhury were the first President and the Secretary of the Governing Body of the college respectively. Noted educa-tionist and a recipient of Padmashri Award recipient Indira Miri was appointed as the first Principal of the college.

The college thereafter operated its academic purposes in a rented house located at Zoo-Road, Guwahati since 15th November 1977. The college has been shifted to its permanent campus of 10 bighas at Geetanagar hill top in 1987. An Assam-type house has been constructed with the effort of local enthusiast people which is being used as an extended campus at present. The college is at present functioning in its new campus behind Geetanagar High School on Mother Teresa Road, Geetanagar, Guwahati-21.

A three-storied building has been constructed with the aid of Guwahati Refinery, Guwahati-20 and Govt. of Assam in the new campus and it has been used for academic purpose.

Kanya Mahavidyalaya is uniquely privileged in having a series of active and dynamic principals dedicated for the cause of higher education for women since 1977. The following have been the principals of college -

REGULATIONS OF THE FOUR YEAR UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMME (FYUGP) GAUHATI UNIVERSITY, 2023

1. Introduction :

The Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) under Gauhati University is based on the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The policy recognizes that higher education plays an extremely important role in promoting human as well as societal well-being. The policy also endeavors developing India as envisioned in its Constitution – a democratic, just, socially conscious, cultured, and human nation upholding liberty, equality, fraternity, and justice for all. NEP 2020 notes that "given the 21st-century requirements, quality higher education must aim to develop good, thoughtful, well-rounded, and creative individuals". The FYUGP is designed to cater to the diverse academic needs of the student and seeks to offer options of multiple entries / exits and obtain a Certificate or a Diploma or Degree with or without Major or a Degree (Honours) or a Degree (Honours) with Research at various levels as stipulated under the policy.

2. Curricular goals:

The curricular and credit framework of FYUGP under NEP 2020 seeks to ensure the following for the students:

- · Flexibility to move from one discipline of study to another
- Opportunity for learners to choose the courses of their interest in all disciplines
- Facilitating multiple entry and exit options with UG certificate/UG diploma/or degree depending upon the number of credits secured

• Flexibility for learners to move from one institution to another to enable them to have multi and / or interdisciplinary learning

• Flexibility to switch to alternative modes of learning (offline, ODL, and Online learning, and hybrid modes of learning).



Structure of courses and credits of the Four Year Undergraduate Programme(FYUGP):

The term undergraduate degree programme denotes programmes like B.A.

The complete FYUGP consists of 8 semesters, to be completed in a minimum of 4 academic years. Each academic year has two semesters. Each semester has a maximum credit allocation of 22. All together the minimum credit requirements for a 3-year programme is 120 and for a 4-year programme, its 160. The minimum credit requirements for GU's FYUGP is as follows:

(a) Semester I : 22 (b) Semester II : 22 (c) Semester III : 22 (d) Semester IV : 18 (e) Semester V : 18 (f) Semester VI : 18 (g) Semester VII, VIII : 40 Total : 160

The medium of instruction and examination will be English and/or Assamese, except in language courses.

FYUGP (Arts)

Intake Capacity : 400 (250 Honours Course - 150 Regular Course) Duration : Four Years (Eight semesters)

Eligibility :

To be eligible for admission to the B.A. 1st semester (FYUGP) class, a student has to pass the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination in Arts or Science stream under the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) or any other equivalent examinationrecognised by Gauhati University.

Admission Procedures :

- A. Online applications will be invited from eligible candidates for admission into B.A. 1st Semester classes for the Session 2023-24.
- B. Admission into college is made STRICTLY IN ORDER OF MERIT AND IS GOVERNED BY ADMISSION RULES. Decision of the Admission Committee regarding admissions is final.
- C. All admissions are strictly on merit, subject to the reservation for quota (SC/ ST(P) ST(H)/OBC/MOBC) as per the standing rules of the Government of Assam. Photocopy of the caste certificate must be attached along with the online application form for admission. Any application form without valid caste certificate will be considered under general category.
- D. A maximum 5% of the seats are earmarked as per break up given below for outstanding Sports Persons/NCC Cadets/Scouts & Guides, proficiency in cultural activities, wards of the employees of the college etc.
- i) 2% for sports persons of sports recognized by IOA/ SAI and also for candidates who have represented district/ State etc.
- ii) 1% for wards of employees of the college.
- iii) 1% for the NCC/ Scouts & Guides.
- iv) 1% for the students with achievements in cultural activities.
- E. No claim for caste benefit will be entertained if the original caste certificate issued by the appropriate authority and countersigned by the DC/ADC/SDO/ SDC concerned is not produced at the time of physical verification of documents.
- F. For the purpose of confirmation of admission into B.A. 1st semester(FYUGP) courses, candidates are required to produce the following in original for physical verification:

- J. Admission into B.A . 3rd semester and B.A. 5th semester will take place immediately after completion of B.A. 2nd and 4th semester examinations respectively.
